

DR. PHIL REID MEMORIAL BURSARY FUND **(Established 1992)**

The Dr. Phil Bursary Fund was established to assist technologists and assistants financially in their advanced education in the field of Medical Laboratory Technology. This assistance has also been available to Medical Laboratory Assistants since the Society welcomed MLA members in 1996. In 1998 the Society extended utilization of this fund to support local academy educational seminars. Particulars of the fund are as follows:

- The Bursary Fund Awards is supported by a \$20,000 term deposit. Total annual awards do not exceed term deposit annual interest. Any interest not awarded at by end of each fiscal year may be assigned to special advanced education-related projects designed to benefit BCSLS members.
- Support may be requested only for seminars, workshops, courses or other continuing education activities related to the field of Medical Laboratory Science.
- An individual applicant must be a BCSLS member in good standing for at least the previous consecutive two (2) years. Applications for individual support have priority. Individuals who wish to organize an activity should approach their local academy.
- Individual applications must be received within six (6 months) after the activity is completed. Applications are reviewed after receipt of the final marks or other proof of successful completion.
- For an academy to apply it must be formally constituted with the Society and in good standing at the time the application is submitted. Only an academy representative may submit an application. The representative should contact the BCSLS Executive Director prior to organizing the activity. An application cannot be submitted for an activity after it has occurred.
- Each applicant is eligible for an award according to the criteria established by the Board/Awards Committee. All decisions are final. If an application is rejected it will not be reconsidered for future disbursements.
- The amount of money awarded to each individual and/or academy depends on the available funds and the number of approved applicants for that year. Eligibility of applicants and the granting of awards are determined by the BCSLS Board/Awards Committee at scheduled meetings.
- Applications are considered only for the funds available in the fiscal year in which the course is completed or activity is completed. Individual applicants must submit original receipts. Original receipts are returned following verification.
