These aren't common tests, but many labs perform these measurements. Why are they done at all? We'll explore some of the clinical indications for these tests and some of the pitfalls in their measurement.

Dr. Cleve obtained his BSc in biochemistry at Brock University, St. Catharines ON, a MSc in physics from University of Guelph, Guelph ON, and his MD from the University of Western Ontario, London ON. He then went on to do a residency in medical biochemistry at McMaster University, Hamilton ON. After residency he took a position with C.J. Coady Associates and started working at B.C. Biomedical labs in October. Starting in January he also serves as the biochemist at Surrey Memorial Hospital and a consultant biochemist to Peace Arch and Delta Hospitals.
